Ordering Information

When ordering from this catalog, we ask that you include the type, year and model of the car that you are working on. It is also necessary for you to include samples of items that are close to those illustrated in the catalog. This enables us to correctly match your needed items to our stock. Please enclose \$2.00 with your sample if you would like your sample returned if we are unable to match it. If the sample can be discarded, you do not need to include this fee. The \$2.00 will be deducted from your order otherwise.

There will also be an additional \$5.00 fee on all drop shipped package.

International Shipping For Our Overseas Customers

We use International Priority Mail or Express Mail. Figure approximately 35% for shipping. Also, the maximum lengths allowed range from 36" to 70", this is subject to postal regulations. Please check with your postal service for this information before ordering.

Window Channel

Window channel is a task that many restorers will not undertake because they feel that it is too difficult. A few simple steps need to be followed to make this job easy to complete. First, check your channel's measurements against those illustrated in the catalog. This will ensure an accurate match. Also, match up the fasteners which attach the channels. When installing you will find that all flexible channel is indeed flexible. Channels or belt strips with beads will bend in a complete circle if handled with care. To do this you must uncrimp the bead on the very end of the pieces. These are crimped closed when the pieces are cut to length. This will allow the bead room to slide past the material, resulting in a nice clean bend. Rigid division bars are held in place with tubular rivets. Removal and installation requires drilling and resetting of these rivets. By using the logic of the above steps, you will be on your way to a complete restoration. Finally, please note that the 96" lengths of channel or belt strips require oversize shipping unless you request that we cut the pieces into shorter lengths to ship. Any item that is shipped in a tube, such as window channel, is subject to an additional handling fee from UPS.

Shipping Delays

At certain times of the year, we have to travel for extended periods of time to attend the various car shows. This is especially true in April, July, September, October and November. Although our shop is open, it is not operating at 100%. Please expect delays in shipping of approximately 2 to 3 weeks during these months.
